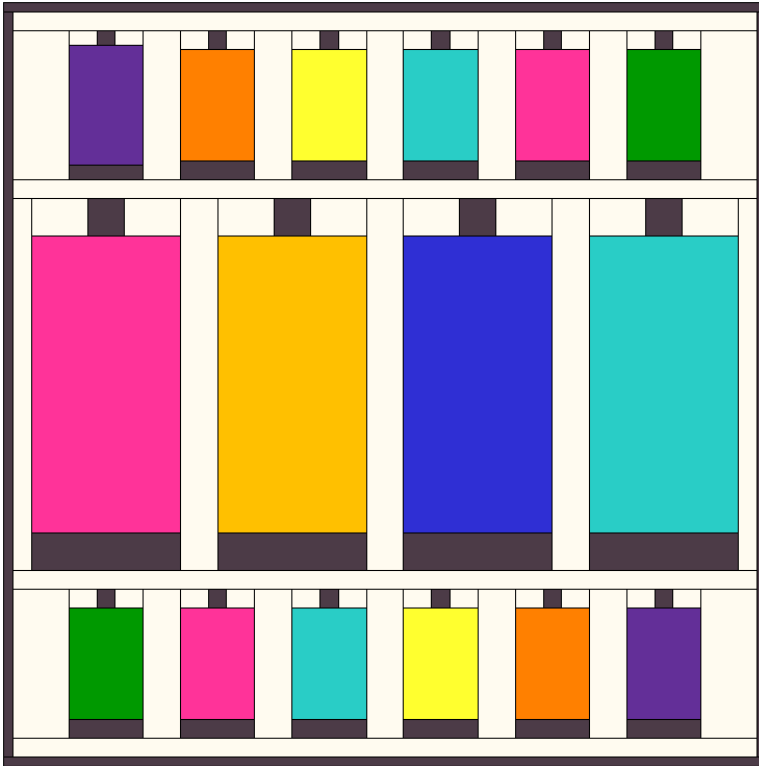




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## Spool-Eze Sewing Machine Mat



### Fabric requirements

Dark Grey .25m  
Background .70m  
Spools .30m - a variety to equal .30m  
Binding .25m  
Backing .70m  
Batting .70m  
Vinyl at least 10" x 21"

### Sewing Machine and Notions

Sewing machine including foot control and cord  
¼" Patchwork foot  
Straight stitch plate  
Walking foot  
70/10 or 80/12 Microtex or Organ HLx5 needles  
Fabric scissors - sharp to the point. I prefer Karen Kay Buckley Perfect Scissors 4" and 6"  
Basic sewing supplies

Spool-Eze Sewing Machine Mat

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Thread to match or blend with background - 50/2wt, 100% cotton DMC, Aurifil or equivalent.  
Used for both piecing and quilting on this project.

### Supplies

Seam Align Glue

Easy Press Pen

Easy Press Fabric Solution

Rotary cutting equipment

Sharpie Ultra Fine Point pen

Bohin Extra-Fine Mechanical Chalk Pencil or equivalent

Double-Sided Tape - Sookwang by Be Creative or equivalent

Painter's Tape - 1" or .94"

Wonder Tape - Wash Away by Dritz or equivalent - this is a double-sided tape made for fabric and gentle on the sewing machine. Never try to sew over other double-sided tape it gums up the needle and is hard on the machine.

### Optional for binding

Deluxe Corner Trimmer by Marti Mitchell

Yellow Stickies 4" x 4" or equivalent

### Class Preparation

Even if you don't normally wash and dry your fabrics before using them in a quilt I stress the importance of washing your fabrics by hand or machine and drying in the dryer **for this class**. Washing the fabric removes chemicals and excess dyes used in the process of making the fabric. Drying fabrics in the dryer shrinks them. Treating and renewing with Easy Press Solution makes rotary cutting, piecing and pressing with accuracy much easier and minimizes fraying and stretching when handling.

1. Wash and dry your fabrics. Wash fabric in cold water on a gentle cycle with a small amount of mild detergent. Tumble dry the fabric until just dry and remove from the dryer. Try to not over dry your fabric as creases will form and will be difficult to remove. Drying the fabrics in the dryer takes about 20 - 30 minutes depending on load size.
2. After washing and drying press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting. Use Easy Press Solution to treat and renew your fabrics. Easy Press adds body to the fabric that the washing process removed and will aid when rotary cutting, piecing and pressing. Use a light touch with the iron when fabric is damp with Easy Press to avoid stretching.
